

DIRECTIONS TO THE HEAD GARDENER'S HOUSE

Easton, Grantham, Lincolnshire

Ideally situated just off the A1, but down a pretty no-through lane, Easton is just 100 miles North of London, between Stamford (16 miles) and Grantham (8 miles) on the Lincolnshire/Rutland border. Grantham is about 65 minutes by high speed train from London King's Cross, and a short taxi-ride will bring you to Easton in under an hour and a half from London.

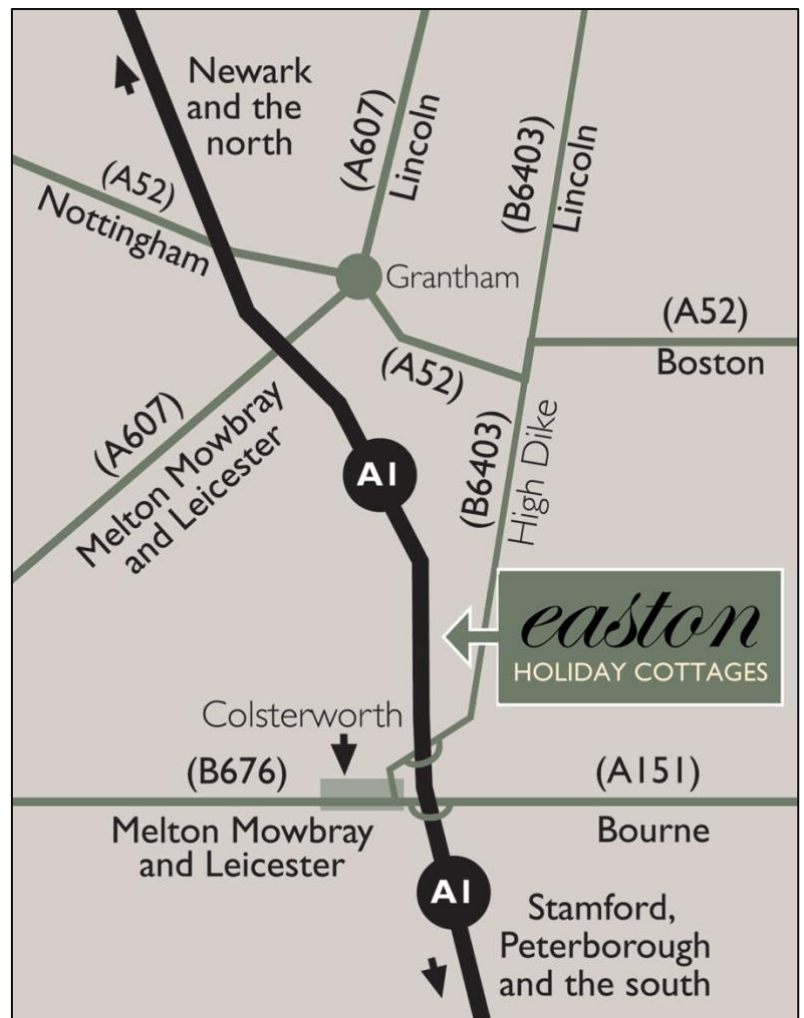
DIRECTIONS BY CAR – PLEASE DON'T TRY TO USE THE A1 FOR ACCESS (WHATEVER YOUR SATNAV TELLS YOU). INSTEAD USE EASTON VILLAGE VIA THE B6403.

From the South

On the A1 go under two bridges at Colsterworth. Just after the 2nd bridge take the left turn to Easton/Ancaster and go up over the bridge. Turn right and continue north for c. 1 mile. Turn left into the small Estate village of Easton. Go down into the village and follow the signs to the Easton Walled Gardens Car Park, which is on the left hand side. Go on past the Car Park until you see a war memorial type cross (w3w hotdog.confident.mankind). Bear right down the hill and over a cattle grid. About 100m past that (w3w dance.basket.champions and it is signposted) turn left onto a track. Follow that across Easton Park for about 600m. You'll see a small cottage on your left. Carry on past that, over another cattle grid, and the gate to The Head Gardener's House is straight in front of you (w3w areas.liver.sidelined).

From the North

5 miles south of Grantham you pass through Great Ponton on the A1. Continue for about 3 miles passing Easton Park and Easton Walled Gardens on your left. Turn left off the A1, signposted B6403 to Easton. 1 mile later turn left into the small Estate village of Easton, as above. Go down into the village and follow the signs to the Easton Walled Gardens Car Park, which is on the left hand side. Go on past the Car Park until you see a war memorial type cross (w3w hotdog.confident.mankind). Bear right down the hill and over a cattle grid. About 100m past that (w3w dance.basket.champions and it is signposted) turn left onto a track. Follow that across Easton Park for about 600m. You'll see a small cottage on your left. Carry on past that, over another cattle grid, and the gate to The Head Gardener's House is straight in front of you (w3w areas.liver.sidelined).



N.B. Our postcode is NG33 5AW. However, if you have satellite navigation it will try and bring you into the cottage from the A1. This is not possible, you need to come in off the B6403, as on the map.
